Garages open up for sale trail

REGISTRATIONS are now open for the annual Garage Sale Trail with 11 councils across Melbourne supporting the event this year.

More than 1.5 million items are expected to be up for grabs through simultaneous garage sales nationwide on Saturday, October 25.

Councils supporting this year's event include Monash, Bayside, Hobsons Bay, Kingston, Melbourne, Moreland, Stonnington, Whitehorse, Wyndham, Yarra and Greater Dandenong.

People are encouraged to get involved to declutter, reuse, meet their neighbours and make some money by holding an event on the day.

Garage Sale Trail co-founder Andrew Valder said the event aimed to promote reuse of good-quality items, reduce waste to landfill, create awareness about illegal dumping, unite communities, and stimulate local economies.

Students' heartfelt gift

PARENTS who have lost a baby stand to benefit from two new cameras donated by a group of community-minded students at Mount Waverley Secondary College.

The middle school leadership group raised a whopping \$1720 for the Heartfelt Foundation last term.

Heartfelt is a volunteer organisation of professional photographers who are called to the bedside of babies that are stillborn, premature, or have serious and terminal illnesses, to provide precious photographic mementos.

A student-run fundraising day paid for two good-quality cameras and instructional videos from Heartfelt to be placed at Monash and Dandenong hospitals.

The students were inspired to take up the cause after a staff member's granddaughter died at birth.

Year 10 student Madu, 15, said her school had a supportive, close-knit community.

"We are there for each other in times of good and bad," Madu said.

The fundraiser included a casual clothes day complete

with sausage sizzle, hot chocolate and a bucket of chalk.

"People drew all sorts of things, from happy bunny faces to slogans promoting positive messages," Madu said.

"After everyone finished drawing, when you looked at it, it was amazing."

Student leadership co-ordinator Hayley Dureau praised the students for their amazing effort.
